WHEREAS, ORS 294.463(1) allows for the governing body to adopt a resolution to transfer appropriations for a specific purpose or purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon was approached by the electric company Pacific Power with an offer to replace 635 streetlights to LED lights; and,

WHEREAS, an adjustment is necessary to cover the cost of replacing the lights which was not budgeted for the current fiscal year, and;

WHEREAS, the total cost to the City for the figure replacement is \$49,239 and operating funds for this purchase cannot be gleaned from existing expenditure authority in the materials & services budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LEBANON CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:
