ZACHARY M. MCKINNEY

IN RECOGNITION OF HIS EXCEPTIONAL ACTION RESULTING IN THE RESCUE OF AN ADULT MALE FROM LIKELY DEATH.

On June 10, 2025, Lebanon Police dispatch received an urgent call regarding a 32-year-old male who was unconscious and not breathing. Officer Zac McKinney, who was in the immediate area, responded without delay.

Upon arrival, Officer McKinney found the male subject unresponsive and purple in color, indicating severe oxygen deprivation. He directed medics to the exact location and without hesitation, immediately began life-saving measures. After checking for a pulse and breathing and finding none, Officer McKinney started chest compressions.

He performed two full rounds of CPR before medics arrived. At the moment the medics arrived, the subject began to breathe on his own. Emergency medical personnel then took over care and transported the individual to the hospital, where he ultimately made a full recovery.

Throughout the incident, Officer McKinney demonstrated composure, decisive action, and an unwavering commitment to preserving life. His quick response and immediate medical intervention were critical and directly contributed to saving the man's life.

In recognition of these heroic efforts, Officer Zac McKinney is hereby awarded the Lifesaving Medal for actions that significantly and directly contributed to the saving of a life.
