### Senior & Disability Services

#### ELIGIBILITY SERVICES & MEDICAL CASES

Medicaid-funded programs in partnership with the ODHS, providing essential support to eligible Oregonians. Including, medical, food, financial assistance, childcare, and more.

#### CASE MANAGEMENT & LONG TERM CARE

**2,806 total cases supported across the region**, including for those receiving in-home care, in a nursing facility, assisted living center, residential care facility, or Adult Foster Home.

#### ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES (APS)

Trained APS workers respond to reports of physical, financial, and other types of abuse, mistreatment, and neglect of older adults and people with disabilities.

#### OREGON PROJECT INDEPENDENCE (OPI)

OPI provides monthly support for daily activities, such as personal care, meal prep, housekeeping, and more. Helping seniors and people with disabilities [maintain quality of life](#).

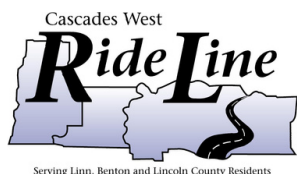
## FOSTER GRANDPARENT PROGRAM
