Subject: Monthly LINX Transit & Senior Center Report

### LINX Transit:

LINX Transit has provided over 40,000 rides at the mid-point of the fiscal year. Following is a ridership summary showing the growth over the years:

- 80,000-85,000 rides projected for Fy25-26
- 75,802 rides for FY24-25, a 18.5% increase from prior FY
- 63,948 rides for FY23/24, a 33% increase from prior FY
- 47,851 rides provided in FY22/23, a 58% increase from prior FY
- 30,021 rides provided in FY21/22, a 36% increase from prior FY
- approximately 20,000 rides provided prior 10 FY's

### Senior Center:

This year, we supported over 60 seniors through our Tree of Giving Program, which is a new record! Community members and organizations were very excited to pick a tag from the tree and honor a deserving unknown friend. Delivering these gifts is always such a joy and being able to see faces light up with happiness as we spread holiday cheer and seniors feel they are cared for and not forgotten.

Our holiday celebration provided fun for up to 50 seniors to get a selfie with Santa, partake in carols and visit with friends. December is a sweeter than average month as we also held an opportunity to share Cocoa and Conversation for our seniors.
