031R - Expressing Intent to Provide Leon Valley Residents with Unlimited Pickup of Loose or Bundled Brush and Bagged Leaves During Semi-Annual Bulk Pickup Periods Through the End of 2024 at No Charge, With Resolution 25-037R -To Discontinue Providing Residents with Unlimited Pickup of Loose or Bundled Brush and Bagged Leaves During Semi-Annual Bulk Pickup Establishing that any Overage Collection Costs Shall be the Responsibility of the Property Owner; and Providing that Failure to Remove or Pay for Overage Collection May Result in the City Covering the

Cost and Placing a Lien Against the Property.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this item is for the City Council to discontinue providing residents with unlimited pickup of loose or bundled brush and bagged leaves during semi-annual bulk pickup establishing that any overage collection costs shall be the responsibility of the property owner; and providing that failure to remove or pay for overage collection may result in the city covering the cost and placing a lien against the property.
