A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY, TX. CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$312,000.00 WITH \$46,800 (15%) FOR CONTINGENCY WITH TANKEZ COATINGS, INC., FOR THE PURPOSE OF REHABILITATING THE HUEBNER ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain existing infrastructure, and the Huebner Elevated Storage Tank Painting and Rehabilitation Project will add another full life cycle of 18-20 years; and

WHEREAS, it is the overall goal of the water utility to provide for the safe and efficient delivery of water services to the citizens of Leon Valley in an economically expeditious manner; and

WHEREAS, the City of Leon Valley budgeted for water improvements in the Fiscal Year 2023 Water and Sewer Utility budget; and

WHEREAS, the estimated budget for this project was \$374,000; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bid is \$312,000.00 from Tankez, Coatings, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Leon Valley City Council desires to accept the lowest responsive bid, and authorize the execution of an agreement with Tankez Coatings, Inc. in the amount of \$312,000.00, with \$46,800 (15%) for contingency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of \$312,000.00 from Tankez Coatings, Inc. for the purpose of constructing the Huebner Elevated Water Storage Tank Painting and Rehabilitation Project is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.
