# Order Setting Public Hearing Capital Improvements Plan Water Impact Fees

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### **Summary**

- Question
  - City Council is being asked to consider ordering a public hearing to consider updates to the Capital Improvements Plan, specifically to discuss and review a proposed increase to the water impact fees

#### Options

- Recommended:
  - Approve
  - Deny
- Declaration
  - The cost of acquiring water rights has significantly increased since the previous fee was adopted



#### **Purpose**

 To consider ordering a public hearing to discuss and review a Capital Improvement Plan water impact fee update



# Purpose/Background

- 5/24 City Council approved an increase to the water impact fees
- Since that time, it has been discovered that the cost for the purchase of water rights has increased much higher than what was originally estimated
- Previous water impact fees were based on acquiring water rights at \$6,100 per acre foot (includes closing costs)
- Since then, it has been found that the cost is now estimated between \$10,600 and \$12,000 per acre foot



# Purpose/Background

- Per state law, to discuss updates to the fees & consider an amendment to the Capital Improvements Plan, Council must adopt an order setting public hearing date & notify the public of the hearing
- Proposed date of the public hearing would be November 19, 2024
  - Impact fees may only be used for improvements to the water and wastewater system that are directly related to new development
  - Can't be used to maintain/replace existing systems & may not be charged to existing customers, unless use changes



## **Fiscal Impact**

 Water impact fees are used to offset the costs of obtaining water rights



#### Recommendation

• At their September 24, 2024 meeting, the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended moving forward with an update to the Capital Improvement Plan to increase water impact fees
