PURPOSE & BACKGROUND A review of City services found that the number of pet licenses issued remains very low. In 2024, only 38 pets were registered with the City, and in 2025, only 25 were registered. Surrounding cities have transitioned to microchip-based pet licensing and now require pets to be microchipped.
