

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER
A COMPLIANCE AGREEMENT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, will hold a public hearing as required by Section 163.3184(6), Florida Statutes, at its regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Levy County Government Center Auditorium, 310 School Street, Bronson, Florida, to consider the following:

A proposed Compliance Agreement (titled “Stipulated Settlement Agreement”) between the State of Florida Department of Commerce and Levy County that sets forth the terms and conditions under which the parties agree to resolve DOAH Case No. 24-1427 in which the Department of Commerce challenged the County’s adoption of Evaluation and Appraisal Amendments to the County’s Comprehensive Plan in Ordinance Number 2023-10.

A copy of the Compliance Agreement may be inspected by any member of the public at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners at 310 School Street, Bronson, FL during regular business hours. Interested parties may appear at the public hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed Compliance Agreement.

In accordance with Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, should any person decide to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at this meeting, such person will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
