

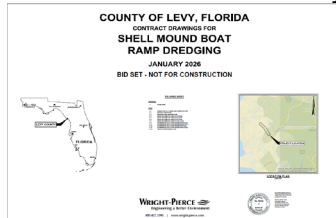
We propose to furnish all Material, Labor, and Equipment for the expected dredged per the proposal below.

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- Bonds and Insurance
 - 100% Payment and Performance Bond of project.
 - Insurance compliance with **Shell Mound Boat Ramp Dredging Bidding/Contract Documents and Technical Specifications January 2026 page 7.**
 - 4. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:** Certificates of Insurance must be provided as proof that Bidder has policies in effect with coverages and limits as follows:
 - a. **Worker's Compensation:** Coverage is to apply for all employees for statutory limits in compliance with the applicable state and federal laws. The policy must include Employers' Liability with a limit of \$500,000 each accident, \$500,000 each employee, \$500,000 policy limit for disease.
 - b. **Commercial General Liability – Occurrence Form Required:** Contractor shall maintain commercial general liability (CGL) insurance with a limit of not less than \$500,000 each occurrence. If such CGL insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this location/project in the amount of \$1,000,000. Products and completed operations aggregate shall be \$1,000,000. CGL insurance shall be written on an occurrence form and shall include bodily injury and property damage liability for premises, operations, independent contractors, produces and completed operations, contractual liability, broad form property damage and property damage resulting from explosion, collapse or underground (x, c, u) exposures, personal injury and advertising injury. Damage to rented premises shall be included at a minimum of \$100,000.
 - c. **Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance:** Contractor shall maintain automobile liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident for bodily injury and property damage liability. Such insurance shall cover liability arising out of any auto (including owned, hired and non-owned autos). This policy shall be endorsed to provide contractual liability coverage.

 - Install 30 mil HDPE liner along cleared ground per **Shell Mound Boat Ramp Dredging Plans** plans sheet C-3 with water runoff towards boat ramp.
- Hydraulic Dredge
 - Furnish and operate 4” trash pump with hydraulic head and centrifugal pump provided by Synergy Pump Division.
 - Access – utilization of wood pallets 4’ x 4’ (roughly) with 4’x8’ plywood to center of anticipated dredged area.
 - Contractor to utilize a separate pressure head to displace solids materials to a goal of -5.5 per **Shell Mound Boat Ramp Dredging Plans** plan sheets C-4 through C-7.
 - Pump material to geotubes 12’-0” x 30’-0” x 7’-0” – approximate 150 cubic yard of dredged material per bag.
 - Contractor has high concerns on the fluidity of the muck material in a basis of controlling the material from extracting outside of the project limits.
 - This material shows a very fluid nature in accordance with **Shell Mound Boat Ramp Dredging Bidding/Contract Documents and Technical Specifications January 2026 page 362 thru page 368 starting at Appendix A** of the provided bidding documents.
 - This material being withdrawn from a -1.5 to a -5.5 elevation with an anticipated slope of 3:1 will show to be a difficult slope transition with this material. It should be known and understood that there is no burrow material to be installed to achieve any type of slopes.
 - Anticipated dredged materials 4,400 cubic yards.
- Dewatering
 - Contractor to provide small 4” trash pump attached to geotube to extract excessive moisture.
 - Polymer is not anticipated for expediting drying process.
- Drying and Disposal of Materials
 - Contractor to allow drying and disposal of materials.
 - Transported in lined trucks.
 - Disposed at local landfill – anticipated haul off of 4,400 cubic yards.
- Performance Turf, Sod
 - Site remediation and Bahia sod installation.

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
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
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- To include grading back to equal or better than previous conditions.
- Erosion control matting or pinning is not included in this cost proposal.
- Utilities Service Connection
 - Disconnection and reconnection of existing utilities required for dewatering and spoils area.
- Surveyor – Subcontractor
 - Voler Group LLC to provide horizontal and vertical benchmarks and verify existing elevations.
 - Provide final as-built plans and digital copies per project documents.

Assumptions bid is based on:

- Dredging equipment provided by Synergy.
- Erosion control materials provided by Hanes Geo.
- All products conform to FDOT Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges and can be located on FDOT Approved Products List.
- All materials for permanent installation conform to Buy America Clause.
- 180 contract days for completion.
- Geotechnical testing is the responsibility of the Owner. Contractor takes no liability for testing IF directed by Owner. All material is deemed safe and non-hazardous per project documents.
- Survey provided by Voler Group LLC.
- All documents provided from OpenGov website.
- Information provided from documents labeled:

Exclusions (Items specifically not included in our quote are as follows):

- Builder’s Risk Insurance is not included
- Engineering/ geotechnical testing.
- Concrete repair, crack injection, or concrete stabilization. It is assumed all material is good and will not spall during constructive efforts.
- Variances if required are not included in our quote.

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- Material and elevations controls outside of project limits cannot be contained or monitored due to fluidity of soils when introduced with excessive moisture/ water.
- Seawalls, retaining walls, or vertical shoring is not included in this proposal.
- We must be provided with local water and electrical access.
- Seawalls, abutments and/or retaining walls.
- Any unsuitable material removal or replacement.
- Mold remediation is excluded.
- Any item not specifically mentioned above as being included is excluded.

The above-described scope of work to be included and excluded along with the pricing and draws listed below constitute the entire agreement. No verbal directions or changes will be considered as valid unless accompanied by a written change order approved by both parties to this agreement.

Any work, changes, manipulations, adjustments, additions, deletions, etc. done to any and all On-Point Contracting Company. lift systems and/or portion of their construction projects, by anyone other than an On-Point Contracting Company employee or representative will void the contract and warranty.

Any and all mitigation fees, including but not limited to those fees associated with obtaining permit compliance will be borne by the homeowner/builder and reimbursed On-Point Contracting Company.

Should the owner choose to utilize their own electrical contractor or perform the electrical work themselves, the electrical work shall not commence until the work included in On-Point Contracting Company contract has been accomplished, the permit has been closed out and the final payment has been received.

You as the Owner are responsible for the operation of your irrigation system during construction. Silt and other deleterious material are stirred up during our jetting. This stirred material may enter the intake of lake fed irrigation systems and may clog the pump and lines. We shall not be responsible for any materials entering the irrigation pump or lines. Please turn your pumps off during construction.

Due to heavy loads of equipment and materials being transported for use on your job, your yard may incur some damage. Specifically, ruts in the sod, accidental leakage on your driveway and/or sod, etc. Therefore, it is requested that any specific instructions concerning the placement of materials, driving of vehicles, etc. be specified to the Project manager at the time of the closing of the contract On-Point Contracting Company. cannot assume responsibility for damage to your sod or driveway unless specific instructions in writing have been dictated to the Project Manager at the time of execution of the contract.

The interpretation and enforcement of this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida unless otherwise provided in the General contract documents and shall bind and the benefits and advantages shall inure to and be enforceable by the parties. Whenever used, the singular name shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.

If it shall be necessary for either party to this agreement to bring suit to enforce any provisions hereof or for damages on account of any breach of this agreement, or under any indemnity provide for in this agreement, the substantially prevailing party on any issue in any such litigation and any appeals there from shall be entitled to recover from the other party, in addition to any damages, interest at a rate of 18% per annum from the date of owing , or other relief granted as a result of such litigation, all reasonable costs and expenses of such litigation and a reasonable attorneys' fee as fixed by the court.

Our prices are based on the information provided. It would be best suited to perform a section of cracks hidden by pavers to reflect a more accurate cost during this time period of the curing and seal testing.

In the event any term or provision of this agreement shall be held illegal unenforceable or inoperative as a matter of law, the remaining terms and provisions of this agreement shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect unless the overall intent of this agreement is substantially defeated by such illegality or lack of enforceability.
