In accordance with Rule Chapter 27P-6, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) has completed its review of the Levy County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP). The approved plan must be formally adopted by resolution of the jurisdiction's governing body within **90 business days**, in accordance with Rule 27P-6.006(11), FAC. A copy of the adoption resolution must be uploaded to the County CEMP SharePoint within **90 business days** of this notice to complete compliance.

Failure to adopt the plan within **90 business days** will result in a notice of non-compliance, unless an extension is requested in accordance with Rule 27P-6.006(11), FAC.
