OpenGov Implementation & Asset Management Reporting	Phase 1 of implementation of OpenGov; began improving reporting processes, data entry consistency, and internal tracking.

Chip Seal Roadway Improvement Program (Alternative Resurfacing)	Identified candidate roads and began preparation of approximately 4.5 miles of graded roads for future Chip Seal application.
<b>Comment:</b>	During this quarter, the department focused on strengthening internal structure and preparing for long-term improvements. Progress included advancing OpenGov implementation and reporting practices, initiating management team development to improve accountability and efficiency, and beginning preparation work for Chip Seal projects as a cost-effective alternative to traditional resurfacing.

### **Department Highlights**

- Increased communication with residents regarding maintenance needs, scheduling updates, and service expectations.
- Grading crews adjusted operations to focus on rebuilding road surfaces for improved long-term road conditions.
- Applied approximately 140 loads per week to priority maintenance areas.
- Initiated Stormwater maintenance on SE 76th Place, CR325, CR326, CR339, and CR343.
- Began initial work phases for the CR 330 Grant project.
- Completed internal training for Maintenance of Traffic (MOT), 14 team members and First Aid, CPR & AED for all team members.
