A Proclamation

Declaring “May 17-23, 2026”, as “*Emergency Medical Services Week*”
In Levy County, Florida

Whereas, emergency medical services is a vital public service; and

Whereas, the members of emergency medical services teams are ready to provide life-saving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

Whereas, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

Whereas, the emergency medical services system consists of first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers, educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses, emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out of hospital medical care providers; and

Whereas, the members of emergency medical services teams, whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their life-saving skills; and

Whereas, it is appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by designating Emergency Medical Services Week.

Now, Therefore, Be It Proclaimed by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida that the week of May 17-23, 2026 shall be known in Levy County as “*Emergency Medical Services Week*”

Be it Further Proclaimed that the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the theme for the week as: “Improving Outcomes, Together.” and encourages the community to observe this week with appropriate programs, ceremonies and activities.
