

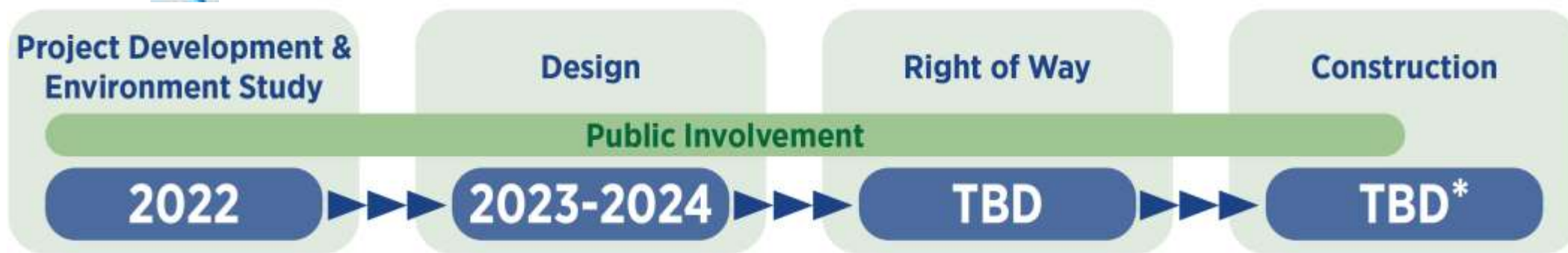

- Citrus and Levy counties
- 43.3 miles

- Uninterrupted flow of traffic along a roadway achieved by the absence of conflict points that slow, impede, or stop the primary traffic movement
