Peanut Harvest Tour



On September 16, Levy County Extension staff and the Florida Peanut Federation hosted a Peanut Harvest Field Day for 8th grade students from Williston, Bronson, Chiefland, and Cedar Key.

The day began with a visit to the Williston Peanuts Inc buying point, where students observed peanuts being weighed, graded, and dried.

Next, they visited a nearby field where employees of Freddy Bell were digging peanuts. Students learned how peanuts grow and how to determine when they are ready for harvest. Following that stop, everyone enjoyed a lunch provided by the Florida Peanut Federation at the watermelon barn of Murray Tillis. There, students explored technological advancements in agriculture, including grid soil sampling, variable fertilizer application, and drone use in herbicide spraying to reduce chemical usage.

The final stop was the field of BJ Wilkerson, where students saw peanuts being picked and loaded into wagons.

The event was an enjoyable and educational experience for both students and adults. The students were actively engaged and asked thoughtful questions throughout the day.




Meet The Agent



Mark Warren and I organized a 4-H summer camp that highlighted agriculture in Levy County. Over the course of three days we toured Quincey Farms, Derby Gold, and Etheridge Cattle Company. The three days were filled with activities including irrigation water contests, construction of bird feeders, FWC meet and greet, a demonstration on cuts of beef, construct a hamburger, and a food dye fruit injection exercise.







Students who attended were from various backgrounds and learned about farming practices for watermelons, peanuts, corn, timber, and cattle production. Our group was interactive, asked great questions, and had fun. The producers enjoyed showing us around their production facilities, engaging with the next generation. We plan to host an agriculture related summer camp every summer so more students are introduced to the importance of agriculture, specifically highlighting Levy County.
