Florida Department of Environmental Protection Tire Amnesty Initiative

The program allows individuals to dispose of waste tires at no cost or a reduced fee with a goal of preventing illegal dumping and promoting proper waste tire disposal. By removing these potential breeding sites, this program will help reduce the mosquito population and the risk of mosquito-borne illnesses.

This program is for residential participation only; commercial businesses are not permitted. Florida DEP will reimburse one entity per county for mileage, processing fees, disposal cost and equipment rental if applicable up to \$25,000 per calendar year. Fuel cost is not included.

Please read all the attached information requirements to participate in the Waste Tire Amnesty Program.

The Tire Amnesty Packet requires registration of contact information in My Florida Market Place, A complete Scope of Work (SOW) on the Florida DEP template provided, a signed Waste Tire Amnesty Checklist must be submitted with SOW. Please complete the participants log sheet during the events and submit with receipts and invoices when requesting reimbursement.

All request for reimbursement must be submitted within 30 days of each event. Reimbursement request must include all invoices, receipts, and log sheets for each request.

Please note that all Waste Tire Amnesty packets must be submitted **at least 2 weeks** prior to hosting the event. All Amnesty Events require prior approval to receive reimbursement.

The Florida Department of Environmental will reimburse each county for mileage, processing fees, disposal cost and equipment rental if applicable up to \$25,000 per calendar year. This program is for residential, and not commercial businesses.

The Tire Amnesty Packet requires the following:

- Applicants must be registered with *My Florida Market Place*
- Complete the Scope of Work (SOW) template
(Please Email both DEP contacts at least 2 weeks prior to the event)
- Sign and date DEP checklist and return with SOW
- Complete DEP Log sheet the day of event.
- Submit complete log sheets with invoices, receipts, and weight tickets for reimbursement **within 30 days after each event.**

***All Amnesty Events require approval prior to any event for reimbursement**

Waste Tire Amnesty Day Checklist

1. ☐ Register or Update contact information in **MFMP** (My FL Market Place).
2. ☐ Complete the Scope of Work (**SOW**) template from DEP Contact with logo added.
3. ☐ Send an Email to DEP Contact with a complete SOW (Scope of Work template) attached. **At least 2 weeks prior to the event *DEP approval is required prior to the event.**
4. ☐ Received **Email confirmation** from DEP Contact that your Scope of Work (SOW) has fully been **approved**.
5. ☐ Receive **Email confirmation** approving your Purchase Order (PO) in MFMP from DEP contact must be received **prior to holding your Waste Tire Amnesty Day Event**.
6. ☐ All Change Orders or Modifications to the Purchase Order (PO), must include an updated Scope of Work (SOW). You must email DEP Contact as quickly as possible about the changes. **You will receive an email reply from DEP contact, confirming the changes with full approval in the MFMP system. If the event is held before confirmed approval, you will not be reimbursed.**
7. ☐ Submit your invoice with all the required documentation.

Date(s) of Event: October 17, 2026 and April 17, 2027

Time: 7:30 am- 5:00 pm

Proposed Plan: Levy (County) will accept 24 (Max Limit 24 tires) per resident with proof of residency during the event. A Photo ID must be presented. Commercial tires will not be accepted. The Department of Environmental Protection will not reimburse the cost of **rims, large tractor tires or off-the-road tires (OTR).**

Levy (County) will provide mosquito control as necessary.

Operational Procedures: Levy (County) will provide staffing, labor and will oversee collection of tires at the event location.

Levy County hauls our tires to

Liberty Tire Recycling, 550 N. Mission Rd., Orlando, Fl. 32808 (disposal location address) for final deposition.

The rate of \$ 130 per ton.

Reimbursement: The state mileage reimbursement rate is \$.445 per mile.

Levy (County) assumes responsibility for advertising the event at least 2 to 4 weeks prior to the event and for staffing of the event. FDEP will NOT reimburse you for advertising or staffing.

FDEP will reimburse Levy County transportation, mileage, processing/disposal costs and equipment rental. All items must be included on the invoice and must have legible receipts and back-up documentation attached. FDEP will reimburse costs up to **\$25,000.00** for waste tires collected during the
