

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2026-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING A DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY FOR LEVY COUNTY TRANSIT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, 49 CFR Part 655, as amended, establishes programs to be implemented by employers that receive financial assistance from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) that are designed to help prevent accidents, injuries, and fatalities resulting from the misuse of alcohol and use of prohibited drugs by employees who perform safety-sensitive functions and 49 CFR Part 40, as amended, establishes how to conduct drug and alcohol test required by Department of Transportation agency regulations, which encompass all Department of Transportation agencies and their designees; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has promulgated a form Zero Tolerance Drug and Alcohol Policy to comply with 49 CFR Part 655, as amended and 49 CFR Part 40, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Levy County Transit has developed its own Drug and Alcohol Policy modeled thereon for the purposes of compliance with 49 CFR Part 655, as amended and 49 CFR Part 40, as amended, and the Board finds that it serves the public health, safety and welfare to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, that:

1. The Levy County Board of County Commissioners/Levy County Transit Drug and Alcohol Policy attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted and shall supersede the policy governing drug and alcohol testing of Levy County Transit employees approved August 2, 2022.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
