AN ORDINANCE OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, FLORIDA STATUTES, ADOPTING A SMALL SCALE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT TO THE LEVY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FROM COMMERCIAL (C) TO URBAN LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (ULDR), FOR PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CHIEFLAND MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONTAINING 2.67ACRES MORE OR LESS; APPLICATION SSA 20-02, APPLICANT JUDITH A. HYDE AND JERRY W. HYDE; PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
