BUSINESS OR INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

LEVY COUNTY COMMISSIONER, JOHNNY HIERS

A. (10:29) Requesting the Levy County Board of County Commissioners direct the Planning Department to return with an analysis and proposed language that provides credit for right of ways.

Audience member, Sara Eastman spoke of an issue she is facing in attempts to get permitted to build on her property. The total property size is reduced due to the small amount of right of way, making it too small to build upon.

County Planner, Tara Howell spoke on this item providing information and stated the language could be reviewed.

Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed by consensus to direct Planning Department and staff to review language and return to the Board with any changes which could be made.

B. (27:35) Requesting the Levy County Board of County Commissioners direct the Planning Department and staff to return with an analysis and proposed language to allow unrecorded subdivisions of 20.01 acres and larger with a private road without platting.

Audience members who spoke regarding this item were: Glen Shepherd, Jr. and Skipper Henderson.

Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed to direct Planning Department and staff to prepare an analysis and provide proposed language as requested at a later date.

LEVY COUNTY MANAGER

A. E. (1:27:17) Requesting the Board appoint a representative to serve on the North Central Florida Homeless Continuum of Care Council (CoC).

Mr. Gayle stated he and Mrs. Conley had spoken about this and agreed Mrs. Conley would take the appointment as representative and he would be her alternate.
