## A Proclamation

Declaring “May 18-24, 2025”, as “***Emergency Medical Services Week***”  
In Levy County, Florida

**Whereas**, emergency medical services is a vital public service; and

**Whereas**, the members of emergency medical services teams are ready to provide life-saving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

**Whereas**, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

**Whereas**, the emergency medical services system consists of first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers, educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses, emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out of hospital medical care providers; and

**Whereas**, the members of emergency medical services teams, whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their life-saving skills; and

**Whereas**, it is appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by designating Emergency Medical Services Week.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Proclaimed** by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida that the week of May 18-24, 2025 shall be known in Levy County as “***Emergency Medical Services Week***”

**Be it Further Proclaimed** that the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the theme for the week as: “We Care. For Everyone.” and encourages the community to observe this week with appropriate programs, ceremonies and activities.
