**AN ORDINANCE OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, FLORIDA STATUTES, ADOPTING AN APPROVED LARGE SCALE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT TO THE LEVY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FROM FORESTRY/RURAL RESIDENTIAL (F/RR) TO AGRICULTURAL/RURAL RESIDENTIAL (A/RR), APPLICATION LSA 20-01, FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, LEVY COUNTY, FOR APPLICANT WILLIAM R. SPELL, III; PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL.**
