SPELL, III, REZONING 62.39 ACRES MORE OR LESS LOCATED IN SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, FROM FORESTRY/RURAL RESIDENTIAL (F/RR) TO AGRICULTURAL/RURAL RESIDENTIAL (A/RR), APPLICATION CZ 01-21; PROVIDING FOR EXCLUSION FROM CODIFICATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
