RESOLUTION NUMBER 2023-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE TO CONSIDER THE CLOSURE AND ABANDONMENT OF PORTIONS OF PLATTED RIGHT-OF-WAY THAT CROSS THE WILLISTON HIGHLANDS GOLF COURSE LOCATED IN LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND DIRECTING PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SAID PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the County has received a petition (Petition Number 2023-007) filed by an adjacent property owner (the "Petitioner") requesting the County close and abandon the following described public road right-of-way located in Levy County, Florida: Those portions of right-of-way that cross the Williston Highlands Golf Course connecting NE 10th Circle to NE 9th Street (labeled Palmer Drive on the Plat) and connecting NE 5th Street to NE 3rd Place (labeled First Street on the Plat), as shown on the plat of Williston Highlands Golf and Country Club, recorded in Plat Book 3, Pages 67 through 67M of the Public Records of Levy County, Florida as described in Exhibit "A" and depicted on Exhibit "B" attached to this Resolution (the "Roadways");

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida (the "Board@) adopts this Resolution for the purpose of setting a public hearing to consider the advisability of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner has represented to the Board that the closing and abandonment of the Roadways will not adversely affect the ownership or right of convenient access of any property owner in the immediate area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that a public hearing on the proposed closing and abandonment of the Roadways be scheduled for Tuesday, December 19, 2023, at 9:00am, or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, and that legal notice of said hearing be published in accordance with Section 336.10, Florida Statutes.
