

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO TASK ASSIGNMENT 2022-04**  
**BETWEEN**  
**LEVY COUNTY AND BARNETT, FRONCZAK, BARLOWE & SHULER ARCHITECTS**

This AMENDMENT NO. 1 is made effective on \_\_\_\_\_, 2023, by and between LEVY COUNTY (the "COUNTY") and BARNETT, FRONCZAK, BARLOWE & SHULER ARCHITECTS (the "CONSULTANT".)

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CONSULTANT entered into "TASK ASSIGNMENT 2022-4 – PHASE 2" for Levy County Courthouse Renovations (the "Project") dated December 2, 2022 (the "Task Assignment");

WHEREAS, the sole proprietor of the Civil Engineering firm "Baytowne Group Inc." identified as a member of the Project Team (in the CONSULTANTS proposal attached as Exhibit "A" to the Task Assignment) has unfortunately passed away and the firm is unable to provide Project services; and

WHEREAS, the CONSULTANT has identified another firm that is willing and able to provide Civil Engineering services for the Project for a slightly higher fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CONSULTANT agree to amend the Task Assignment as follows:

1. Exhibit "A" to the Task Assignment is amended by removing Baytowne Group, Inc. and substituting Gmuer Engineering, LLC, as the Civil Engineering firm for the Project and by increasing the fee for Civil Engineering services from \$11,500 to \$15,000, all as described in the letter from the CONSULTANT (with attachments) dated March 1, 2023 attached to this Amendment No. 1.
2. As a result of the Civil Engineering fee increase, Section 2 of the Task Assignment is amended by increasing the Compensation to be paid to the CONSULTANT from a not to exceed amount of \$145,950.00 to a not to exceed amount of \$149,450.00 for the services described therein.
