EMERGENCY ORDER

No. 2021-072

AN EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING OPEN BURNING DURING THE DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Emergency Declaration No. 2021-071 dated June 1, 2021, the Chair

of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") declared a state of local emergency due to

the drought conditions and forest and brush fires in Levy County; and

WHEREAS, several activities create unacceptable risks for accidental or careless

ignition of dry vegetation with the potential to cause forest or brush fires, including but not

limited to open burning and use of burning or combustible items; and

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Board has been requested by the Florida Forest Service

of the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services ("Florida Forest

Service") to take steps to adopt an order implementing a voluntary burn ban for activities that

threaten the health and safety of persons and property due to their high risk of creating

damaging forest or brush fires; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the home rule powers authorized by Article VIII, Section 1,

Florida Constitution and Section 125.01, Fla. Stat., and the powers and authorities provided

in Section 252.38(3), Fla. Stat., including but not limited to the power and authority to provide

for the health and safety of persons and property, the Board may take actions to protect the

health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Board finds it necessary to promulgate an emergency

order to implement a voluntary burn ban to protect human life and animal life and to avert the

overwhelming destruction of property that could result from a forest or brush fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- That the following activities be prohibited in the unincorporated area of Levy
 County, Florida, for the duration of this Emergency Order:
- (a) Open burning, except (i) outdoor grills used in preparing food; and (ii) commercial land clearing where on-site inspection and approval has been granted by the Florida Forest Service, on a case-by-case basis, and it is determined that there will be sufficient fire suppression equipment and personnel on-site.
- (b) (i) The sale, use and/or discharge of items listed in Section 791.01(4), Fla. Stat., (fireworks) using explosive or cornbustible compounds; (ii) use or discharge of flares, and the use of outdoor burning devices (excluding attended and monitored barbecue/cooking equipment); and (iii) any otherwise lawful outdoor burning, such as lawn, debris or trash burning.
 - (c) The throwing of matches or cigarettes or any lit object from vehicles.
- 2. The purpose of this Emergency Order is to obtain voluntary compliance from citizens and visitors to Levy County to protect the health and safety of persons and property throughout Levy County. Violations of this Emergency Order will carry no penalty or punishment from County code enforcement officers or County law enforcement.
- 3. If any provision of this Executive Order is invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Executive Order, which shall continue to have the full force and effect of law.
- 4. This Executive Order shall remain in effect during the state of local emergency declared by Emergency Declaration No. 2021-071, as the same may be extended, but in no event longer than June 30, 2021, unless either modified or rescinded.
