In any zoning district, a building permit may be 17 issued for a structure on a nonconforming legal lot of record, provided that: the use 18 19 of the structure is permitted in the zoning district; required setbacks are met; and the lot abuts a street a distance of at least 30 feet or has access via an easement 20 serving no more than two lots and which easement connects to a public street. 21 22 (b) Accessory structures and uses on lots. On lots of 5 acres or more in size, 23 accessory uses and structures are allowed prior to a principal use or principal 24 structure and may be located anywhere within the yard. On lots less than 5 acres 25 in size, no accessory uses or structures is are allowed until a principal structure 26 exists on the lot and the accessory uses or structures must may be located in the 27 side yard or rear anywhere within the yard. Each accessory structure must meet 28 required setbacks. 29 30 (c) Corner lots.
