Department Highlights – 3rd Quarter

During the third quarter, we made the most of the favorable weather conditions to complete a significant amount of road grading. However, we are continuing to face increasing challenges due to population growth along many of our limerock roads. One major concern is the issue of water retention and drainage—particularly on roads that lack sufficient ditches or right-of-way space. As we move into the rainy season, we recognize ongoing drainage issues and are actively working to manage each affected area.

Our construction crews have also begun hurricane repair work on Airport Road in Cedar Key. We recently completed repairs to the bridge approach at Daughtry Bayou and repaved the section where asphalt had been washed out. Additionally, we've met with insurance adjusters and engineers to discuss the replacement of the airport's electrical vault, lighting system, and Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS). These efforts have brought us one step closer to putting the project out for bid.

Construction is also nearing completion on our SCRAP project along County Road 347, from ALT 27 to US 19. Anderson Columbia has finished paving the roadway and is now completing final tasks, including ditch work, bridge components, and signage installation.
