FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS **FIRST AMENDMENT** is made effective as of **January 1, 2025** (the "Effective Date") between **Levy County**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") and **Baxter & Woodman, Inc.**, an Illinois Corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida **d/b/a** "**Tocoi Engineering, a Baxter & Woodman Company**" ("Consultant.") The County and the Consultant are collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the County is amenable to consenting to the Assignment as requested pursuant to Section 11.1 of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The County consents to the assignment and, as of the Effective Date (stated above), the Consultant for purposes of the Agreement shall be "Baxter & Woodman, Inc., d/b/a Tocoi Engineering, a Baxter & Woodman Company."
- 2. Article 9 Notices (as to Consultant) is amended as follows:
