EMERGENCY ORDER

RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2021-072 REGARDING OPEN BURNING AND OTHER ACTIVITIES DURING THE DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Emergency Declaration No. 2021-071 dated June 1, 2021, the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") declared a state of local emergency due to the drought conditions and forest and wildfire threat in Levy County, which declaration of local emergency was ratified by the Board and later extended by the Chair through Emergency Declaration No. 2021-073; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the home rule powers authorized by Article VIII, Section 1, Florida Constitution and Section 125.01, Fla. Stat., and the powers and authorities provided in Section 252.38(3), Fla. Stat., the Chair of the Board adopted Emergency Order No. 2021-072 instituting a voluntary ban on certain activities to reduce the threat of brush fires or wildfires in Levy County, which Emergency Order No. 2021-072 was ratified by the Board on June 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as the result of the findings in Emergency Declaration No. 2021-075, dated on even date herewith, that the drought and wildfire conditions no longer pose a threat to the County and that the local state of emergency has now terminated, the Board finds it would be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the County citizens that Emergency Order No. 2021-072 be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Emergency Order 2021-072 is hereby rescinded.
