EMERGENCY DECLARATION 2021-075

A DECLARATION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA RESCINDING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING OPEN BURNING AND OTHER ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Levy County Board of County Commissioners enacted Emergency Declaration Number 2021-071 which was based on extreme drought conditions that caused an increased potential for brush fires and extreme fire conditions, and created a serious threat to the public health, safety and welfare, which was effective June 1, 2021, and which was ratified by the Board of County Commissioners on June 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Chair executed Emergency Declaration 2021-073 extending the declaration of a local state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, extreme drought conditions no longer pose a threat to Levy County; and

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the threat or damage which gave rise to the adoption of the above-mentioned Emergency Declarations 2021-071 and 2021-073 and the local state of emergency no longer exists.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that: Emergency Declaration Numbers 2021-071 and 2021-073 establishing and extending a local state of emergency are hereby terminated and shall have no further effect.
