RE: Levy County Auditorium Acoustical Renovation

Acoustic Distinctions (AD) is pleased to submit our proposal to provide professional consulting services related to the control of the acoustic environment within the Levy County Government Center Auditorium, Bronson, FL.

BACKGROUND

Levy County, located in Bronson, FL is seeking acoustic improvements to their commission meeting room, which is a 1950's high school auditorium. The county acquired the building a few years ago and has since converted it into the county offices.

Our work will be directed to achieving the appropriate acoustic environment within our scope of work area, in compliance with the client's functional and performance goals and budget. This includes appropriate levels of sound isolation to control intrusive noise, low background noise levels, and control of reverberant sound energy.

SCOPE OF WORK

A. ACOUSTIC STUDY

- 1. Review available documentation (drawings, photographs) of the project and its audio systems prior to our site visit.
- 2. Conduct an acoustical survey to quantify the characteristics of the existing environment including:
 - a. Room Acoustics
 - b. Sound isolation
 - c. Background noise
 - d. Vibration levels



The quantitative acoustical survey will need to be scheduled at a time when there is no other activity taking place in the building. It also requires someone to be available to switch on and off the HVAC systems and any other systems that serve the acoustically critical space(s).

- During our site visit, participate in an interactive programming session that will explore project goals and provide the opportunity to collaborate on what is possible for the project. Discussions will focus on:
 - a. The desired experience for users of the space
 - b. Range of uses and prioritization of the space
 - Simultaneous use of the space and any adjacent spaces in order to establish sound isolation criteria.
 - d. Mechanical and electrical systems noise and vibration issues in order to establish background noise level criteria.

B. DATA ANALYSIS, RESEARCH, AND REPORT

- Conduct analysis of all measured data from the site visit in the context of the program input received during the programming discussions. Perform additional research as required to develop appropriate recommendations.
- 2. Prepare and submit an acoustics report that includes the following:
 - a. Summary of understanding of the user's requirements
 - b. Statement of acoustical design criteria
 - c. Survey results
 - d. Findings and recommendations as appropriate to achieve acoustic design goals identified during the programming session which may include details, sketches, mark-ups, specifications, and product literature.
 - Supporting design details and specifications for recommended corrective measures
- Reasonable follow-up to acoustics report to review our recommendations with the client and
 provide support, answer questions, etc. We have budgeted for a maximum of 10 hours related to
 this collaboration after completing our recommendations.
- 4. Optional: We are available to provide services during the construction phase, if requested. Such services may include responding to questions from the contractor that arise during construction, answering RFI's, review of submittals, etc. We can also provide site visits during or at the completion of construction, to confirm that acoustics aspects are constructed in strict conformance with the construction documents. After each site visit, we issue a Site Inspection Report that can be included in the architect's punch list for the Contractor.

Expenses

Terms

Invoices will be submitted by email on a monthly basis, with appropriate supporting documentation. Payments are due and payable within thirty (30) days after submission. Amounts unpaid thirty (30) days after invoice date shall bear interest from the thirty-first (31st) day following the invoice date at the rate of 1.5% per month (18% per annum).

SCHEDULE

We are prepared to begin our work immediately upon receiving written authorization to proceed. We will issue our Report within 12 business days following our site visit.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional services not in this proposal may include but are not limited to the following

- a. Providing services related to spaces or systems other than those described above.
- b. Providing detailed recommendations for upgrades to the existing audio systems serving the auditorium (we assume that we will be working with a local AV integrator who will lead any upgrade design efforts based on our input).
- c. Redesign or revisions to drawings, specifications or other documents prepared by us, when due to change in programming criteria or when such revisions are inconsistent with written approvals or instructions previously given by Owner or Architect, or are due to causes beyond our control.
- d. Attendance at meetings or site visits additional to those allocated within this proposal.
- e. Providing Services during construction/implantation of our recommendations, including proof of performance acoustic testing at the end of construction.
- f. Providing services made necessary by the default of the Contractor or by major defects in the work of the Contractor.
- g. Providing support more than 90 days after issuance of our recommendations report.



Should additional services be desired, a proposal for these services will be submitted for review and authorization prior to commencing services.

ACCEPTANCE

This proposal/agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior oral and written agreements. No waiver or modification to the terms of this agreement is valid unless contained in a written document signed by Acoustic Distinctions.
