6. Describe the existing system

Levy County's existing primary E911system is a Type 4, E911 Intrado Viper call handling equipment with MapFlex mapping display, located in the Levy County Sheriff's Office. This system has been serving Levy County since October 2009. The original system was upgraded in July of 2015 and again in December of 2021. Levy County's PSAP consists of 5 positions. The system includes a NICE recorder and Power Metrics is used for MIS.

Florida is split into seven 9-1-1 regions; Region 3 is pursuing grant funding for two projects: 1) Regional GIS Data Merging and 2) Data Sharing and NG911 Data Development. The region consists of the following 15 counties:

Alachua County, Columbia County, Gilchrist County, Putnam County, Baker County, Dixie County, Levy County, St Johns County,

Bradford County, Duval County, Marion County, Union County, Clay County, Flagler County and Nassau County,

7. Describe the scope of work

The focus of this project is to provide managed services to establish a system to supply the region 1 GIS data repository with updated GIS data. This project will include vendor services to assess, improve, and provision data GIS data to the regional repository. This project will ensure that GIS data updates are properly affected in Levy County's portion of the regional repository. Levy County is also seeking vendor services to provide GIS data hosting services for tactical mapping (Mapped ALI). GIS Data hosting services will establish a direct connection between the regional repository and the PSAP's tactical mapping application. When GIS data is updated in the regional repository, those updates will be immediately affected in the PSAP's tactical mapping application. This solution is currently being used in FL PSAP's i.e., all 12 counties in region 1.

The following phases/milestones/deliverables will be used to provide updates on project completion and reimbursement needs.

Phase 1 (0-45 days)

*Continue providing GIS managed services and regional repository updates

Phase 4 (180 and ongoing)

- *Configure data hosting services
- *Configure GIS components for tactical mapping i.e. display parameters, geolocators, etc.
- *Establish rest endpoint services for tactical mapping.
- *Provision rest endpoint services to tactical mapping application

8. Justification of the need for the proposed project

Levy County is participating in the Region 3 GIS data repository. Upon completion of the GIS repository's GIS data validations, the county has become aware of numerous GIS data anomalies that need to be corrected in preparation of NGCS, spatial call routing and location validation.

The county does not have sufficient resources to perform these corrections nor to ensure the GIS remains at a state of NG9-1-1 readiness moving forward.

The county is seeking a vendor to provide managed services that will help assess, improve, and provision data into the regional repository. The county also needs assistance with ensuring GIS data is properly provisioned into mission critical systems such as it's tactical mapping solutions.

The county does not have local resources to establish workflows for continual updates to tactical mapping applications within the PSAP.

The county is seeking vendor provided managed services to host GIS data for tactical mapping applications. These managed services will provide automated updates to dispatch mapping applications used in the PSAP to answer and dispatch 911 calls. Up to date GIS data is a critical component for daily operations within the PSAP. The county wishes to establish automated workflows similar to the ones currently deploy in FL Region 1

9. Justification of grant funding

Due to limited funding, Levy County does not have sufficient resources to bring the GIS data into compliance with NG9-1-1 standards nor continue NG9-1-1 compliancy moving forward. Without grant funding the county will not be able to provide GIS continuity for the regional repository nor be able to update their tactical mapping environment with GIS data provided from the Region 3 GIS Repository.

The county will be using a GSA Contract as a procurement vehicle. GSA was used by Levy County to procure the region 3 repository. The county plans to use the same contract to procure additional managed services. By using a GSA contract the county will be receiving pre-approved pricing. This means that the federal government has already determined the pricing as fair and reasonable by government standards, the pricing also has a ceiling rate for all products and services.

The vendor's technical capabilities are also pre-vetted prior to a GSA contract being awarded.
