# Arc of Levy County may find a new home in Chiefland

The nonprofit which supports adults with developmental and intellectual disabilities made its home for many years in Otter Creek. This property was built in the 1930s and fell into disrepair. The Arc sold the property, and Levy donated land to the organization.

The organization found a temporary home at the fellowship hall of Saint Alban's Episcopal Church of Chiefland.

However, according to Arc board president Ris-

sa Johns, the nonprofit is now in a unique position. They do not have the funds to build on the land given to them by the county. In order to make more funds, they need to bring in more clients. While there are those who need services in the area, Arc does not have the space to bring in those clients.

However, a local property owner has offered to own-finance the purchase by Arc of his property on US 19, a former childcare

facility just north of Bett's Big T Restaurant. This would get them into a larger location that allows them to increase their clientele.

Representatives of Arc approached the Levy County Commissioners about the offer.

"However, we don't want to do anything without this commission's support and blessing because this organization would not be where we are without the Levy County commission and we're wanting your

blessing and your input before we do anything," said Johns.

The commission was supportive of the Arc and agreed to assess the property for health, safety and welfare of the new occupants.

"That's a great thing about Levy County, that people from the public step up and they come to help when you need help. And it sounds like that's happening," said Commissioner Matt Brooks.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2023-11

AN ORDINANCE OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA RELATING TO MANURE COMPOSTING AND DISPOSAL; BY CREATING A NEW ARTICLE WITHIN CHAPTER 22 - BUSINESSES; BY AMENDING CHAPTER 74 - SOLID WASTE; BY AMENDING SEC. 2-140 TO PROVIDE CIVIL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE AND PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE CLERK AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
