


**TASK ASSIGNMENT 2025-2**  
**ISSUED UNDER AN AGREEMENT FOR CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

THIS TASK ASSIGNMENT 2025-2 is entered into by and between LEVY COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (the "County") to Locklear & Associates Professional Corporation, a Florida Corporation (the "Consultant"), pursuant to the Agreement between Levy County and Consultant for Continuing Professional Services dated November 21, 2023 (the "Continuing Professional Services Agreement.")

1. Scope of Services. Commencing on May 6, 2025, Consultant shall provide engineering services for improvements to the Development Department Office (this building is located at 355 Mongo Street, Bronson, FL) to include conversion of the existing septic system to sewer; expansion of parking lot; expansion of stormwater management system; sidewalks; and landscaping (the "Services") as described in the Proposal dated April 21, 2025 attached as Exhibit "A" (consisting of three pages.)
2. Compensation. County shall compensate Consultant for its performance of the Scope of Services as set forth in the Proposal. Invoices or requests for payments to Consultant shall be made in accordance with the Florida Local Government Prompt Payment Act, sections 218.70 through 218.79, Fla. Stat.
3. All terms and conditions of the Continuing Professional Services Agreement not in conflict with this Task Assignment 2025-2 shall apply to Consultant's services.



WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interests of the County to purchase the equipment and supplies requested by the Fresno County Board of Education, and

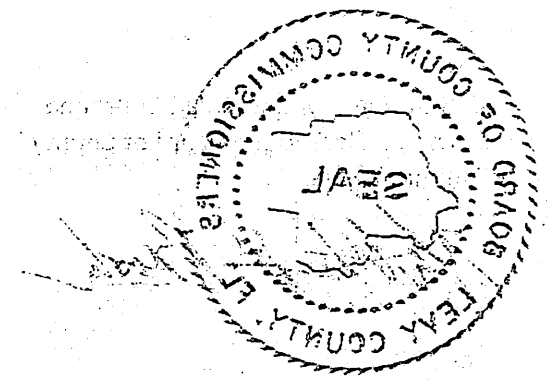

Dear Ms. Harper:

We appreciate the opportunity to submit this proposal to provide professional engineering services to Levy County. We understand that the County would like to make improvements to the existing infrastructure at the County Development Office located at 310 School Street in Bronson, Florida. Improvements include conversion of the existing septic system to sewer; expansion of parking lot; expansion of stormwater management system; sidewalks; and landscaping.

### Scope of Services

  - o Calculate sewer flows
  - o Design required sewer pipe size and components
  - o Design parking lot and ADA sidewalk

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## Assumptions & Exclusions

- o No modifications to existing buildings will be necessary
- o The City wastewater treatment facility is assumed to have adequate capacity to allow for connection
- o It is assumed that no existing utilities will need to be moved for the new parking lot, sidewalk, or driveways
- o No wetland impacts are anticipated

## Schedule


Locklear is prepared to start work immediately on this project. We anticipate that the workscope defined herein will require approximately six months to complete from the date of Notice to Proceed. The final project duration may be impacted by regulatory agency review timeliness.

## Fee

The scope of services described herein will be completed for a lump sum fee of \$51,700. This includes geotechnical and surveying subconsultant costs as well as permit application fees.
