
Dear Mr. Ward:

This letter is to formalize and finalize the fact that the Florida Game and Fresh Water Fish Commission (GFC) has officially abandoned the Elkins Road boat ramp (Section 3, Township 17 South, Range 16 East).

This ramp is on the Withlacoochee River, west of Inglis and was built by the GFC in cooperation with Levy County in a handshake agreement. Since there was no official paperwork involved, my supervisors and I thought it would be best to at least write a letter to officially document the close of our dealings with the Elkins Road boat ramp.

You may remember our conversations from April 1991, and before with Mrs. Carol Risher, about letting the ramp revert back to the county or city. This ultimately was done because there was no parking for users and no land could be bought around the area. The GFC had to delete the ramp from the program because no funds can be used on ramps that do not have adequate parking space for users.
