**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA,
AMENDING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR
2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida on September 20, 2022, held a public hearing as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, and adopted Resolution 2022-55 approving the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 (the "FY22-23 Budget"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 129.06(2), Florida Statutes, this Resolution is required in order to amend the FY22-23 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, that:

1. The FY22-23 Budget is amended as follows:

The State Mosquito Control Fund (104) is increased by \$867 due to receipt of additional revenue from the State as set forth in the budget amendment form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

- Ensure all columns are properly completed
- Verify the amounts provided accurately reflect your detailed work plan
