

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL FROM THE PUBLIC RISK MANAGEMENT PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE POOL; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE ALL REQUIRED NOTICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida ("Board"), participates in the Public Risk Management Property and Casualty Insurance Pool for the purpose of obtaining property and casualty insurance coverage and related risk management services; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Levy County to obtain property and casualty insurance coverage through another provider beginning with the next policy period; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to withdraw its participation in the Public Risk Management Property and Casualty Insurance Pool in accordance with the applicable participation agreement, bylaws, and all other governing requirements, including any required notice provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that authorizing the withdrawal and directing staff to complete all actions necessary to effectuate the transition serves a valid public purpose and promotes the efficient administration of County government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals.

The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Authorization to Withdraw.

The Board hereby authorizes the withdrawal of Levy County from the Public Risk Management Property and Casualty Insurance Pool, effective upon the expiration of the County's current coverage period or such other date as permitted under the participation agreement and applicable governing documents.

Section 3. Authorization to Execute Documents.

The Chair of the Board is authorized to execute any notices, agreements, acknowledgments, or other documents necessary to effectuate the County's withdrawal from the Public Risk Management Property and Casualty Insurance Pool.

Section 4. Authorization to Provide Notice.

The County Manager, or designee, is authorized and directed to provide any required written notice of withdrawal and to take all administrative actions necessary to complete the transition of the County's property and casualty insurance coverage.

Section 5. Severability.

If any provision of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions, which shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
