Department Highlights

-Fleetio, Fleet Software Implementation: In April, our department initiated a major milestone by jointly logging all work orders, parts tickets, and fuel usage logs into our new software, Fleetio, while temporarily maintaining our older system, SquareRigger. This intentional period of parallel testing ensures that as we actively transition and systematically troubleshoot potential system bugs, our team retains the ability to generate critical daily work orders and compile comprehensive monthly fuel reports for the Clerk's official records.

Also, running these two systems side-by-side provides a valuable, real-time opportunity to compare the overall data accuracy, user simplicity, and administrative efficiency between the two programs.

While our team is still learning the system and finding the extensive array of specialized features and advanced perks that Fleetio has to offer, our onboarding experience so far has been positive and encouraging. Looking ahead to the next phase of our modernization roadmap, we will begin strategically transitioning our entire parts inventory over to Fleetio. Additionally, we plan to deploy dedicated mobile tablets to our floor staff for real-time work order management and immediate parts check-ins—a major tech upgrade that will streamline our workflow and eliminate clerical, hand-entered data errors.

-Verizon, GPS Deployment: Following the finalization of our comprehensive fleet policies and procedures, the Human Resources department successfully distributed the documentation to all employees to initiate the mandatory review and signature collection process. Following that, the physical installation phase of the new hardware officially began and has proven very successful up to this point. Our team remains actively engaged in managing these deployments as units arrive, maintaining a steadfast focus on achieving complete installation across the entire fleet.

Upon the completion of these GPS installations, we will unlock the capability to grant all department heads direct access to a comprehensive, near real-time, 360-degree operational dashboard. This visibility will fundamentally transform oversight of daily departmental activities. Furthermore, the Verizon Connect platform will seamlessly integrate with our primary fleet management software, Fleetio. This powerful synchronization will ultimately facilitate significantly more accurate, streamlined, and efficient tracking capabilities for the entirety of Levy County's fleet operations.
