

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE BOARD OF THE CENTRAL FLORIDA COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY, INC.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article III of its Bylaws, the Board of the Central Florida Community Action Agency, Inc. (the “CFCAA”) must be representative of the ethnic and gender makeup of the three-county service area consisting of Alachua, Levy, and Marion Counties and of the tripartite-structured sector arrangement prescribed by Community Services Block Grant (“CSBG”) policies set forth in 42 U.S.C. 9901 and associated federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 4 of the CFCAA bylaws provides that Public Sector members of the CFCAA Board “shall be designated in writing by the appointing authority, public official, or publicly elected body, and be reaffirmed on an annual basis”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, finding that it is in the best interests of Levy County, now desires to appoint Layce Hallman to the CFCAA Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT. Layce Hallman is hereby appointed to the Central Florida Community Action Agency, Inc. for a term of commencing on the effective date of this Resolution. The term would extend through September 30, 2026.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
