**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR A
2025-26 TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED TRIP AND
EQUIPMENT GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA COMMISSION FOR THE
TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$390,298;
PROVIDING DIRECTION AND AUTHORIZATION TO THE COUNTY
MANAGER OR DESIGNEE; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged administers the State Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund and provides grants to eligible recipients for the specific purposes of funding a portion of trips provided to eligible passengers and/or for the purchase of equipment to be utilized in a designated service area; and

WHEREAS, the County is eligible to receive a Transportation Disadvantaged Trip and Equipment Grant and to undertake a transportation disadvantaged service project as authorized by Section 427.0159, Florida Statutes and Rule 41-2, Florida Administrative Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, that:

1. The Board has the authority to apply for a Transportation Disadvantaged Trip and Equipment Grant (the "Grant") and, if the Grant is awarded, to enter into a Grant Agreement on behalf of the County.
2. The Board, through its staff, is aware of the obligations, including the local match requirement that will result from the award and acceptance of the Grant.
3. The Board hereby approves the Grant Application for 2025-26 in the amount of \$390,298 and authorizes and directs the County Manager, or designee, to submit the Grant Application (signed by the Chair) and to execute the Grant Agreement, amendments, warranties, certifications and any other documents which may be required by the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged in connection with the Grant.
4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
