

**RESOLUTION  
NUMBER 2025-27**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY AS  
SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION OF THAT  
SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION  
2-320 OF THE COUNTY CODE AND SECTION 274.06,  
FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, as set forth in Resolution Number 2024-76 adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on November 19, 2024, the County accepted the donation of three travel trailers from the State Division of Emergency Management and planned to dispose of those travel trailers to homeowners who were displaced (rendered homeless) as a result of storm damage in the 2024 Hurricane season;

**WHEREAS**, the County offered the travel trailers to displaced homeowners and only one accepted, leaving the County with two travel trailers;

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to put those two travel trailers to beneficial use by offering them to homeowners who are displaced (rendered homeless) as a result of damage to or destruction of their home from any cause (e.g., storms, flooding, fire;)

**WHEREAS**, as County staff estimates the value of each travel trailer to be less than \$5,000, Section 274.06, Florida Statutes, allows the County to dispose of same in the most efficient and cost-effective means as determined by the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board adopts this Resolution to declare the two remaining travel trailers surplus and to direct the method of disposition to serve a public purpose.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** The following personal property is declared surplus: the two remaining travel trailers identified by VIN numbers 4X4TWDU21P7376927 and 1NL1G2111P1170689 (the “Surplus Property”).

The County Manager, and designee(s), are authorized to dispose of the Surplus Property on a first come, first serve basis to any Levy County homeowner who has been displaced (rendered homeless) as a result of damage to or destruction of their home from any cause (e.g., storms, flooding, fire.)

Ownership of each travel trailer will be transferred from the County to the homeowner by execution of a Bill of Sale (Attachment A) and Application for Certificate of Motor Vehicle Title (Attachment B) and receipt of a Donation Acceptance and Acknowledgement from the homeowner (Attachment C.)

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
