

**RESOLUTION
NUMBER 2024-88**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA,
AMENDING THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR
2024-2025 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,643 BY
TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM VARIOUS ACCOUNTS TO
PURCHASE MULTI-DEPARTMENTAL SOFTWARE;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida on September 17, 2024, held a public hearing as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, and adopted Resolution 2024-52 approving the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (the "FY24-25 Budget"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 129.06(2), Florida Statutes, this Resolution is required in order to amend the FY24-25 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, that:

1. The FY24-25 Budget is amended as follows:

The General Fund (Fund No. 001) is increased by \$20,129 due to a transfer of funds from Capital Projects and Replacement Fund (Fund No. 301) and those funds are appropriated for purchase of OpenGov software by the Planning and Zoning Department as set forth in the budget amendment form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

\$60,385 is appropriated from the Building Inspections and Safety Fund (Fund No. 134) in order to increase the specified expenditures in that Fund for the purchase of OpenGov software by the Building Inspection Department as set forth in the budget amendment form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

The General Fund (Fund No. 001) is increased by \$20,129 due to a transfer of funds from Capital Projects and Replacement Fund (Fund No. 301) and those funds are appropriated for purchase of OpenGov software by the Code Enforcement Department as set forth in the budget amendment form attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
