## PARTIAL TERMINATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS HURRICANE HELENE (2024)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in Chapter 30 of the County Code, on Tuesday, September 24, 2024, the Chair issued Administrative Order #1 announcing mandatory evacuation and ordering the opening of public shelters; and on Wednesday, September 25, the County Manager issued Administrative Order #2 expanding the area of mandatory evacuation, all as necessary for the preservation of life, property and/or for emergency mitigation, response, and/or recovery (collectively, the "Administrative Orders"); and

**WHEREAS**, the County Manager, in consultation with the County Emergency Management Director, has determined it appropriate to issue this Partial Termination of Administrative Orders.

## NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNTY MANAGER HEREBY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:

- 1. Effective at 5pm on Friday, September 27, 2024, the Administrative Orders are partially terminated as follows:
  - a. the evacuation orders therein are rescinded; and
  - b. County staff is directed to close the General Population Shelters in Bronson and Williston.
- 2. The Special Needs Shelter in Bronson will remain open at this time.
- 3. Continued County response to the Storm is authorized until such time as the Declaration of Local State of Emergency has expired or is terminated by appropriate action of the Board, Chair, Vice Chair and/or County Manager.
- 4. In accordance with Section 252.46, Florida Statutes, this Termination shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court and Ex Officio Clerk to the Board within 3 days after its issuance, and shall be posted on the County's designated website <a href="https://levydisaster.com">https://levydisaster.com</a>.
