RE: DOCK ST. LIVING BREAKWATER SHORELINE AND INFRASTRUCTURE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM (HMGP) SUPPORT

Mr. MacDonald,

It is our understanding that Dock Street's infrastructure and businesses are uniquely vulnerable to storm surge caused by Hurricanes and severe weather. There is currently no protection against damage to infrastructure or structures caused by storm surge along this critical economic and cultural sector and past events have caused damage to the pier, road, seawall, and businesses along Dock Street. As such, the County has successfully applied for and received HMGP funding to construct a living breakwater that runs parallel with Dock Street, west from the bridge overpass to the end of the boat ramp on the east providing protection against storm surge, flooding, erosion, and subsidence.

It is also our understanding that Levy County is looking for HMGP support utilizing the existring contract between AC Disaster Consulting (ACDC) and Levy County. As such, ACDC proposes the following services to support the County with the Dock Street Living Breakwater project:

- HMGP progress and fiscal reporting
- Project monitoring and compliance
- Project closeout
- Data management and records retention

Pursuant to the existing contract for Disaster-Related Recovery Services, ACDC proposes the following positions to support Levy County with HMGP support and a Not To Exceed (NTE) amount of \$156, 056.25.

Program Manager: \$165/hrProject Manager: \$160/hr

Assistance Project Manager: \$150/hrSubject Matter Experts: \$155/hr

• IMT/EOC Finance Section/Unit Support Staff: \$75/hr
