ORDINANCE NO. 2021-015

AN ORDINANCE OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE RELATING TO FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION; BY AMENDING SECTION 50-1 TITLED "DEFINITIONS"; BY AMENDING SECTION 50-131 TITLED "ADOPTION AND ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS"; AND BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS WITHIN ARTICLE VI. TITLED "FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION"; ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

All interested persons may appear and be heard at the public hearings. The meeting may be continued to one or more future dates. Any interested party shall be advised that the date, time and place of any continuation of this meeting shall be announced during the public hearing and no further notice regarding these matters will be published, unless said continuation exceeds six calendar weeks from the above referenced meeting. All persons are advised that, if they decide to appeal any decision made at a public hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
