A Proclamation

Declaring “April 2026”, as “*Water Conservation Month*”
In Levy County, Florida

Whereas, water is one of our most valuable natural resources and is essential to the health, well-being, and economic vitality of our community; and

Whereas, The State of Florida, Water Management Districts and Levy County continue to work together to raise awareness about the importance of protecting and conserving our water resources; and

Whereas, Levy County and the State of Florida have designated April, typically one of the driest months of the year and a time when water demands are highest, as Florida’s Water Conservation Month to encourage citizens to use water wisely; and

Whereas, Levy County supports water conservation through community education, outreach efforts, and partnerships that promote responsible water use and stewardship of our natural resources; and

Whereas, conserving water helps protect Florida’s rivers, springs, lakes, and groundwater supplies while supporting a strong environment and sustainable economy; and

Whereas, outdoor irrigation accounts for a significant portion of water use and improving irrigation efficiency can greatly reduce unnecessary water consumption.

Now, Therefore, Be It Proclaimed by the Levy County Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaims the month of April 2026 as “*Water Conservation Month*”
