The applicant seeks approval for amendment to the current PUD 21-01 that would provide clarification regarding location of uses, building form, and accessory supportive uses. The application does not expand the site's boundary, nor expand or increase intensity of approved adopted PUD uses. The project is located on parcel number 0368400100 and is approximately 90.23 acres. The project site is in the Future Land Use Category and Zoning District of Forestry/Rural Residential with a current PUD overlay zoning. The project address is 450 SE Co. Rd 337, Bronson, Florida 32621.
