**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM
TAXES FOR LEVY COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR
2020-2021, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, on September 8, 2020, adopted Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Tentative Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Levy County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Board of County Commissioners as \$2,088,442,266.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Levy County, Florida, that:

1. The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 operating millage rate for the Board of County Commissioners is 9.0000 for the General Fund which is higher than the rolled-back rate of 8.5247 mills by 5.58%.
2. The County has no voted debt service millage.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


