	A local state of emergency was declared on March 17, 2020 by the Chair of the Levy County Board of County Commissioners as a result of the effects of COVID-19. On March 9, 2020 Governor Ron DeSantis issued numerous Executive Orders related to the state of emergency including a stay at home order except for essential services and activities, which temporarily closed all schools and necessitated virtual classes. Then on April 19, 2020, Governor DeSantis declared all schools would remain closed for the remainder of the school year and classes would be through virtual distance learning. This has resulted in the seniors of the 2020 graduating classes to miss out on the rituals established by past graduating classes for their senior year.
