Please accept this resume for the position of *Public Information Officer*.

I bring with me a unique combination of education and experience that I believe will serve Levy County very well. My background includes more than 30 years of experience in the career, combination, and volunteer fire service, serving at various levels within state and local agencies in the northern and southern United States. Most recently, I have worked as a Public Safety Consultant since 2018, first as the Director of Operations for Emergency Services Consulting International, which is the Consulting Firm of the International Association of Fire Chiefs, and then as a Principal and Owner of my own company, Dynamix Consulting Group. Working as a Public Safety Consulting has afforded me the opportunity to assist fire departments across the country in engaging their stakeholders to review their data and to develop plans for the provision of fire and rescue services in their communities. Projects included short-term Strategic Plans, long-term Master Plans, Fire Station Location Evaluations, Community Risk Assessments: Standards of Cover, Staffing Studies, Fire Training Facility Evaluations, and a variety of other custom projects.

In all of these positions, I was charged with understanding the needs of my stakeholders and then motivating the members of my team to meet or exceed the expectations of those stakeholders.
